The number of abortions occurring in Wisconsin each year has steadily declined from over 19,000 in 1982 to fewer than 8,300 today!


## Polls indicate we are winning the CULTURE OF LIFE war!

For the first time, more Americans self-identify with the Right-to-Life position.

A widely reported 2009 Gallup poll found 51% of Americans now call themselves pro-life compared to 44% the previous year.

Conversely, 42% now call themselves pro-choice compared to 50% the previous year.

A Pew Research survey found that most of this strong shift to the Right-to-Life view was among young people ages 18-29.
