Office	Candidate	Record on Life
U.S. President	Hillary Clinton (D)	As a U.S. Senator, Hillary Clinton maintained a 0% pro-life voting record. In 2009, Clinton was awarded Planned Parenthood's Margaret Sanger award.
U.S. President	Donald Trump (R)	"Let me be clear...I am pro-life... I did not always hold this position, but I had a significant personal experience that brought the precious gift of life into perspective for me."
U.S. Senate	Russ Feingold (D)	Feingold has a 0% pro-life voting record with National Right to Life. In his time in the U.S. Senate, he voted against the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act every chance he got.
U.S. Senate	Ron Johnson (R, Inc)	Johnson has a 100% pro-life voting record with National Right to Life and has co-sponsored every major pro-life bill in the U.S. Senate.
U.S. House (District 7)	Mary Hoeft (D)	Did not return a candidate questionnaire.
U.S. House (District 7)	Sean Duffy (R, Inc)	Has a 100% pro-life voting record with National Right to Life.
WI Senate (District 12)	Brian Van Stippen (D)	Did not return a candidate questionnaire.
WI Senate (District 12)	Tom Tiffany (R, Inc)	Has a 100% pro-life voting record with Wisconsin Right to Life.
WI Assembly (District 35)	Renea Frederick (D)	Did not return a candidate questionnaire.
WI Assembly (District 35)	Mary Czaja (R, Inc)	Has a 100% pro-life voting record with Wisconsin Right to Life.
WI Assembly (District 36)	Jeff Mursau (R, Inc)	Has a 100% pro-life voting record with Wisconsin Right to Life, but now is in favor of physician-assisted suicide, which leaves those who are elderly, those who are living with disabilities, or those with chronic illnesses vulnerable to coercion & abuse.
