Office	Candidate	Record on Life
U.S. President	Hillary Clinton (D)	As a U.S. Senator, Hillary Clinton maintained a 0% pro-life voting record. In 2009, Clinton was awarded Planned Parenthood's Margaret Sanger award.
U.S. President	Donald Trump (R)	"Let me be clear...I am pro-life... I did not always hold this position, but I had a significant personal experience that brought the precious gift of life into perspective for me."
U.S. Senate	Russ Feingold (D)	Feingold has a 0% pro-life voting record with National Right to Life. In his time in the U.S. Senate, he voted against the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act every chance he got.
U.S. Senate	Ron Johnson (R, Inc)	Johnson has a 100% pro-life voting record with National Right to Life and has co-sponsored every major pro-life bill in the U.S. Senate.
U.S. House (District 1)	Ryan Solen (D)	Is for federal funding of Planned Parenthood and Obamacare.
U.S. House (District 1)	Paul Ryan (R, Inc)	Has a 100% pro-life voting record with National Right to Life and has championed every major pro-life bill in the U.S. House.
U.S. House (District 2)	Mark Pocan (D, Inc)	Has a 0% pro-life voting record with National Right to Life.
U.S. House (District 2)	Peter Theron (R)	Strongly supports legislative measures that would protect life.
